

Locally produced *The Last Lullaby* coming to Shreveport-Bossier screens

In 2009, "The Last Lullaby" will be coming to Shreveport-Bossier screens. Financed and shot entirely in Louisiana, LULLABY (www.thelastlullaby.com) stars Tom Sizemore and Sasha Alexander. This locally produced movie is currently enjoying a great film festival run, but now it could use your help.

Director Jeffrey Goodman says, "You, as a citizen of our region, will have the rare opportunity to affect whether this film gets out to the rest of the world. " He states that the film's launch will occur in May of 2009. He emphasizes, "If a large number of people in the region come out in support of the film, it has a great chance of being shown on screens in the rest of the world." Specifically, when the film opens, Goodman is aiming to make LULLABY the independent film with the highest per screen average in the country.
